

CASH: Visitors may bring no more than \$10.00 in coins for use in the available vending machines. The Visiting Room no longer accepts money in any form (e.g. cash, checks or money orders) from Visitors for the purposes of being posted on an inmate's individual account. Money to be posted on an inmate's individual account will only be accepted through the facility's Post Office.

SMOKING: Smoking and the use of any other tobacco product within the visiting area is prohibited. Visitors are **NOT** permitted to bring into the Visiting Area any tobacco product and/or tobacco paraphernalia (e.g. matches, lighters, etc.).

FOOD & BEVERAGES: Visitors are not permitted to bring food or beverage items into the Visiting Room area (with the exception of the one baby bottle for small children). There are vending machines available within the Visiting Room for use by inmate visitors.

Visitors found defacing or damaging State property will be barred from the facility and removed from all approved inmate visiting lists.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION & AREA LODGING

The city of Montgomery located approx. nine (9) miles from MOCC provides access to public transportation in the form of private taxi service, Amtrak and KRT.

The nearest public lodgings are located in Glen Ferris, WV & Gauley Bridge, WV (approx. 17 miles distance from MOCC on Rt. 60 in Fayette County).

The Charleston, Summersville, Beckley areas are the nearest largest source of public lodging.

Telephone Directories and Contact numbers for public transportation and lodging are available in the MOCC Visiting Room lobby. Visiting Room staff remain available to assist visitors in contacting public transportation or lodging services.

DIRECTIONS TO MOCC

From Charleston, WV: Travel east on I-64/77 to Exit #85. Cross over the Admiral TJ Lopez Bridge and merge onto Rt. 60 east. Travel approx. 12 miles to Smithers, WV. At the traffic light, turn left onto Cannelton Hollow Road. MOCC is located approx. seven (7) miles from that point.

From Beckley, WV: Travel west on I-64/77 (WV Turnpike) to Exit 74 (Paint Creek Road) and follow Paint Creek Road to Rt. 61 (approx. 6 miles). Turn right on Rt. 61 approx. 5 miles to Montgomery, WV. Cross the Kanawha River and merge onto Rt. 60 (east) entering into Smithers, WV. At the traffic light, turn left onto Cannelton Hollow Road. MOCC is located approx. seven (7) miles from that point.

From Summersville, WV: Travel south on US 19 to the Midland Trail (Rt. 60) exit (approx. 15 miles south of Summersville). Turn right (west) on Rt. 60 and travel approx. 25 miles to Smithers, WV. At the traffic light, turn right onto Cannelton Hollow Road. MOCC is located approx. 7 miles from that point.

Welcome to the Mount Olive Correctional Complex (MOCC) Visiting Room. Our goal is to provide a comfortable and supportive atmosphere for the visitor and the inmate, while ensuring the security of the public and safety of all. We ask that each of you work with us, and understand our duties and responsibilities in trying to meet the balance of courtesy, efficiency and security. This brochure contains general information concerning the MOCC Visiting Room procedures. Complete rules and regulations will be provided at the institution. If you have any additional questions regarding our Visiting Room, please feel free to speak to our Visiting Room Staff.

VISITING TIMES

Slayton Work Camp Visiting Times: The visiting of inmates in the Slayton Work Camp is by appointment only. All visits will take place in the Mount Olive Correctional Complex Visiting Room.

Call Friday-Monday 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to arrange a visiting time. Visiting times are Saturday and Sunday, 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR VISITORS

IDENTIFICATION: All Visitors must be on the inmate's approved visitor list and must provide two (2) forms of identification. Visitors eighteen (18) years of age and older must have at least one form of identification bearing their photograph (e.g. Driver's License). The second form of identification may be any other document identifying the individual, such as a Voter's Registration Card, Insurance Card, etc. However, a Social Security Card or a Credit Card **will not** be accepted as a valid form of identification. Visiting Room staff may require further identification when deemed necessary.

All minor children must be accompanied by their custodial parent/guardian (who must be on the inmate's approved visitor list) with proper documentation to include an original or certified copy of the child's Birth Certificate and a second form of identification (e.g. Passport, School or State ID, etc.).

SEARCHES: Visitors involved in the introduction of contraband onto the grounds are subject to immediate loss of visiting privileges and criminal prosecution. WV State Code 61-5-8 prohibits any alcoholic liquor, non-intoxicating beer, poison, explosives, firearms or other dangerous or deadly weapon or controlled substance, as defined by WV State Code 60A-1-101, on the grounds of the prison. Cash is also considered contraband for inmates. All visitors must successfully complete a magnetometer, canine and pat-down search, as directed by MOCC staff prior to entry. If a visitor refuses to have his/her vehicle searched, they will be immediately escorted from the property and denied a visit on that day.

SEARCHES (Continued): All children that are accompanying visitors will be searched in the presence of the custodial parent/guardian accompanying them. MOCC reserves the right to search any vehicle coming onto facility grounds. Vehicle searches that result in the seizure of any contraband (as described above) the visitor(s) will be permanently banned from participating in the MOCC visiting program. MOCC reserves the right to also contact the WV State Police for further action.

DRESS CODES: All visitors must be fully dressed, including shoes. Only children five (5) years of age and younger will be permitted to wear shorts.

Female Visitors: *NO* tube tops, halters, shorts, sweat suits, jogging suits, plain gray sweatshirts, provocative or low cut clothing, sleeveless garments, under-wire bras (although a bra must be worn), bibbed overalls, jewelry (other than engagement ring, wedding ring, and religious medallion), hats/caps, or clothing adorned with excessive metal.

Male Visitors: *NO* jogging suits, shorts, tank tops, sweat suits, plain gray sweatshirts, light-brown/khaki/Camouflage shirts and pants of any type, bibbed overalls, jewelry (other than wedding band and religious medallion), hats/caps, or clothing adorned with excessive metal.

NUMBER OF VISITORS: A maximum of three (3) visitors will be permitted for any one inmate at any given time, with minor children in the same family counting as one (1) visitor.

LENGTH OF VISITS: Visits may be shortened, limited, or terminated due to staffing, to accommodate a large number of visitors, facility disturbances or other causes at the discretion of MOCC Senior Management. Visits may also be terminated if inmate or visitor behavior is found to be disruptive to the Visiting Room's smooth operation

SEATING: Visitors will remain at their assigned tables and will not visit other tables. Infants and children are to remain with the adult visitor who brought them.

PHYSICAL CONTACT: Lewd behavior and/or physical contact of a sexual nature between inmates and visitors is **PROHIBITED**. Visitors may embrace the inmate upon arrival and departure. Inmates and visitors may sit side by side at their assigned table. Inmate may drape one arm around the visitor and hold hands. However, both inmate and visitor's hands must remain in plain view at all times. Children under the age of eleven (11) may sit on the lap of a parent. No article of clothing or any other item may be laid across the lap of inmate and/or visitor.

VISITOR PROPERTY: Visitors will be permitted to bring approved property into the Visiting Room. However, MOCC will not be responsible for property left in vehicles. Lockers are available to secure personal items not permitted within the Visiting Room area. The following items are permitted within the Visiting Room: **ALL OTHER ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED.**

- Identification Cards/papers;
- Engagement/wedding ring and religious beads or necklace. (no other jewelry permitted);
- One (1) of each of the following: Belt, Plain White Handkerchief, Pair of Suspenders.
- \$10.00 in coins (see "Cash" for additional details);
- Keys (House/Car only), medications, feminine hygiene products will be secured in a locker provided in the Visiting Room Waiting Area.

When a small child is visiting, the following will be allowed: One (1) clear plastic bottle or "sippy" cup containing only milk or juice and one (1) baby blanket. Diapers and accessories must be stored in available lockers. A diaper changing area is available in the Visitor's Waiting Room. Note: Breast feeding is not permitted during visiting

Visitors are not permitted to bring any item (e.g. funds, pictures, etc.) into the Visiting Area to give to an inmate. Approved items will only be accepted through an authorized special package processed through the facility's Post Office
